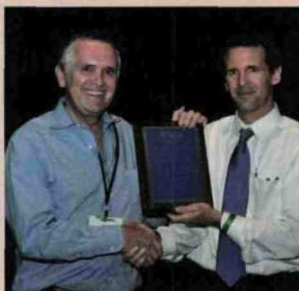

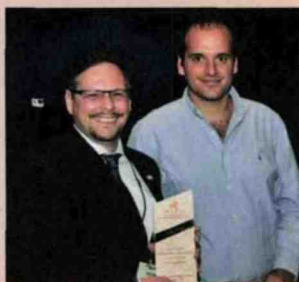
Nano Awards

Two awards were presented during the conference.
